## Support Services Committee May 17, 2012 John Schilling

The Support Services Committee met on April 30th and discussed the following:

- Punch lists and Contract closeouts for the North Wales and General Nash Elementary School Renovation Projects were discussed. A change order for each of those projects was proposed and appears on tonight's agenda.
- It was reported that the TV Studio HVAC Remediation project is completed.
- The request from Hatfield Township to allow additional storm water to flow through the storm sewer on the A. M. Kulp School property was discussed. This item was tabled until next month's meeting when new information is expected clarifying the request.
- The NPHS Hot Water Heater and Inglewood Elementary School Additions and Renovation projects approved last month have begun. We have received approval from PDE approving PlanCon Part F for the Inglewood Project and acceptance of that approval appears on tonight's action agenda.
- A reimbursement opportunity with submission of PlanCon Part H for the Natatorium Project at NPHS was discussed. Assuming the state has the funds, reimbursement could begin to be received for this project. This was discussion moved to a future Board Work session.
- The last complete Facilities feasibility study was conducted in 2002 with updates to that study in 2004, 2006 and 2008. A complete new feasibility study would be required for any future projects and could be helpful with possible future facility use and student assignment decisions.
- The committee heard an update on Energy Management initiatives including continued energy savings, the possibility of using natural gas at buildings currently only burning fuel oil, and the possibility of using natural gas as fuel for the school buses.
- As of April **ALL SCHOOLS** Qualify as Energy Star labeled buildings.
- The committee asks for your support for the following:
  - > Change Orders for the North Wales and Gen Nash Elementary School projects
  - Acceptance of PDE's approval of PlanCon Part F for the Inglewood School project
