I. Informational Items

A. EIT / Transfer Tax and Delinquent Property Tax

Irene Dickinson reported that all were above budget for 2012-13 fiscal year. EIT was approximately \$1.4 million above budget. Berkheimer has reported that they expect the 2013-2014 estimated totals to be around \$13.6 million in revenue which will be \$600,000 above budget.

B. Enterprise Fund Statements

Nutrition Services - Bob Schoch reported that there have been personnel changes that are expected to improve the bottom line for School Nutrition Services in the 2013-2014 fiscal year.
