Update

I. Informational Items

- A. Revenues/Expenses & Balance Sheet Bob Schoch reviewed highlighting an estimate of \$3 million favorable.
- **B.** General Fund Financial Reports Bob Schoch reported that property tax collections in September made up for August slow processing and low receipts.
- **C. Salary Schedule** This schedule is currently estimated at \$381,214 less than the budgeted amount due to unexpected resignations and retirements.
- D. EIT / Transfer Tax All entities had strong revenues in June 2013. In the first three months of this year, the revenues have exceeded last year by 31%

E. Enterprise Fund Statements -

- Community Education has strong revenues in the Aquatics program.
- Extended School Care is remaining consistent with last year.
- Pam Gallagher from Nutrition Services will report next month on how plans to economize are working. Initial results appear to be on target.
