Prohibition on Use of Tobacco Products or Electronic Cigarettes

Reference: Administrative Regulation #5144

The board of school directors recognizes its responsibility to ensure a safe and healthful environment for all students of the district. The school board further recognizes that smoking poses a significant health risk to smokers and nonsmokers alike. Therefore, smoking, possession of tobacco products or electronic cigarettes, and/or the use of tobacco products or electronic cigarettes in any form is prohibited by students in all district buildings, on district property, and in all school district vehicles.

Any student who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action, as defined in the school district discipline code. Any student who violates this policy may also be subject to a civil fine.
