

Dear Hatfield Families,

Thank you to those who were able to join us last Thursday for Back to School Night (BTSN). We are very appreciative for the parent/guardian support in which we have received thus far, and look forward to continued and increased collaboration in the future.

During BTSN, parents were provided an informational letter regarding 2018-19 Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) results for students who were in grades 3-6. Hard copies were distributed yesterday to those unable to attend BTSN. With that, student scores have also been placed into the Parent Portal of the Infinite Campus platform.

Additional paperwork was distributed regarding our school-wide Title I programming. Translated materials can be made available by contacting the Main Office or your child's homeroom teacher. While in the classroom, we asked parents/guardians to sign a Title I Compact. For those unable to attend, they were also sent home with students. Please ensure that they are signed and returned as soon as possible.

Lastly, as a reminder, please be sure to follow our morning arrival protocols. Students should be dropped off by vehicle on the side of the school. Only school buses should utilize the front of the school. We are fortunate to have two separate entrances for these purposes. If bringing your child to school, please pull all the way up around the circle and next to the curb. Students should start to arrive at approximately 8:55 a.m. Remember, students are not permitted in the building until 9:00 a.m. At this time, teachers are in the classroom and breakfast is served. Opening exercises and instruction begins promptly at 9:10 a.m. Students should be settled in — and should not be arriving to school — at that time.
