Thank you to our K-2 students, parents/guardians, and staff for their patience and persistence this week. We will continue to work through technological issues and establish productive patterns for our children via reflective collaboration.

Please know that the district released it's COVID-19 dashboard yesterday, It will track COVID-19 confirmed cases among in-person students and staff and will be updated daily. Click here to view the [NPSD COVID-19 Data Dashboard](#).

For those who celebrate, Happy Halloween! Please be mindful of social distancing if you plan to Trick-or-Treat tomorrow and/or attend a social gathering.

Remember, there is no school for students on Monday, Nov. 2 and Tuesday, Nov. 3. If you would like to touch base with your child's teacher, please be sure to reach out to them as soon as possible to potentially plan a virtual check-in/meeting.

Additionally, we are continuing to refine our arrival and dismissal protocols. Next week represents three more days of practice for our K-2 kiddos. Once grades 3-6 return starting on Nov. 9, these processes will become busier. For K-2, during afternoon pick-up, be sure to bring the numbered car hang tag and or/ laminated placard with you! These items have already been sent home with your child, and they will be provided to our grades 3-6 children on their first day.

For those using bus transportation, be sure to utilize students' H1/H2/5D, color-coded backpack tags. These help our drivers organize student days and allow more time to support with assigned seating.

Next, students are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle to school with them. Be sure that it is tightly sealed in backpacks, and that a parent/guardian sanitizes it on a daily basis. We have water bottle

refilling stations throughout the school. Students should not be using water fountains, so please discuss this with your child. For those without a water bottle, cups can be provided by teachers upon request.

Lastly, please stop by Vinny's Pizzarama from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 4.
