Dear Hatfield Families,

We enjoyed a successful first week of live-streaming combined with having some hybrid students across all grades learning in-person. Thank you for supporting both your children and our teachers!

As a reminder, departure on Fridays during hybrid learning is scheduled for 1:35 p.m. Students exit the building via three access points (bus riders in the front, car riders on the side of the building near the playground, and walkers in the back of the school near the path). The same access points will be utilized in the morning beginning at 8:55 a.m.

Students should bring a fully-charged Chromebook to school on a regular basis. For additional support with technology, please reference below:

Hybrid Student has an Inoperable Chromebook

- An exchange can be facilitated at Hatfield. Note, both the device and charger must be swapped.
- Students will receive a replacement Chromebook; they will not receive the broken device after repair.

100% Virtual Student has an Inoperable Chromebook

- Inform the teacher.
- Make an appointment to exchange the Chromebook at North Penn High School by clicking here: [NPSD Appointment Form](#).
- Both the device and charger must be swapped.

Student is in School, but Forgot their Chromebook

- Students will be provided with a loaner laptop (not a Chromebook) for the day.
- The loaner device will not go home with the child and will be returned to a central location.
- Returned devices will be sanitized.

Next, be sure to bring numbered car hang tags and/or laminated placards to parent pick-up. For those using bus transportation, be sure to utilize students' H1/H2/5D, color-coded backpack tags. These help our drivers organize student days and allow more time to support with assigned seating.
