

Dear Hatfield Families,

May has arrived and we are continuing along our collective journey of online distance learning through the end of the school year come June. Thank you to those who have provided us feedback pertaining to our ongoing instructional planning and delivery, as well as taking the time to work with your children on a regularly structured basis.

Know that if your child needs to swap out a device due to technological concerns, they can do so at Gwynedd Square Elementary School between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 7. Before arriving, please contact npfamilytech@npenn.org so that they can assist in preparing a device.

As a reminder, North Penn's School Nutrition Services is providing breakfast (three meals) and lunch (another three meals) on Monday and Thursday from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Hatfield. Parents/guardians do not have to have their children in the car during pick-up. Know that it is available to children 18-and-under.

Next, for those in need of food, assistance is available via the North Penn Mosque. Note, this organization, as well as the one noted below, is not affiliated or endorsed in any way by the North Penn School District or Hatfield Elementary. We just want all families to be aware of the option. Their address is 600 Maple Avenue in Lansdale. Pick-up options are from 2:00-4:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

Similarly, the Emmanuel EC Church's food cupboard, located at 100 South Main Street in Hatfield, also provides distribution once per week. Service is available in the order in which patrons arrive, with volunteers bringing food out for curbside pickup (i.e.: no shopping). A photo ID and proof of residency is required. This month's dates are as follows: May 5 (5:30-6:30 p.m.); May 14 (1:00-2:00 p.m.); May 20 (5:30-6:30 p.m.); and May 28 (1:00-2:00 p.m.).
