

Dear Hatfield families,

I hope that the first few days of summer are treating our Hawks well!

School Nutrition Services will continue to offer meals throughout the summer with distribution days held on Monday and Thursday from 11:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Pick up locations will be located at the student drop off lane of the following schools.

- Hatfield Elementary School, 1701 Fairgrounds Road, Hatfield, PA 19440
- Oak Park Elementary School, 500 Squirrel Lane, Lansdale, PA 19446
- Inglewood Elementary School, 1313 Allentown Road, Lansdale, PA 19446
- Kulp Elementary School, 801 Cowpath Road, Hatfield, PA, 19440
- Penndale Middle School, 400 Penn St, Lansdale, PA 19446

Grab-and-go lunches and breakfasts will be provided to any children 18 years old and younger. Families will be able to pick up three days' worth of meals on Monday and four days' worth of meals on Thursday per child... Families are asked to stay in the car during distribution. Meals will be passed through windows. Meals must be eaten off-site. No identification or student information is required."

Next week, we are planning to send additional information regarding our summer enrichment program and Freckle access. An overview video for families was already sent last week. Programming is scheduled for release the week of June 29. The intent is for select teachers across the district to have synchronous office hours four days per week over the summer. This way, live support is available for questions within this optional learning platform. Student-choice boards will be provided for five weeks. Stay tuned for follow-up information.
