

Dear Hatfield Families,

Today represents our last day of formal instruction for the 2019-20 academic year. Remember, attendance will be taken throughout the week based on completion of assignments. As stated in my previous outreach, the remaining days of our online distance learning program are outlined below:

- School concludes for children on Friday, June 12. Third trimester report cards (i.e.: distance learning parent/guardian feedback) will be available in the Infinite Campus parent portal on this day.
- Work (practice and review) will still be provided for students on Tuesday, June 9 and Thursday, June 11.
- We will hold "Specials Wednesday" on June 10.

On Wednesday, June 10, we will hold an opportunity for parents to retrieve student belongings from school. During that time, books (textbooks and those from the library) will also need to be returned. Medication will be available for pick-up throughout the day. Also on that day, there will be a Sixth Grade Committee tent set-up on the right-side of the building.

Additionally, in regard to instruments, per Mrs. Cohen, "If your child will not play again next year, you want to contact Zeswitz at 610-406-4300 or www.zeswitzmusic.com to let them know 'You want to end your lease and close your account.' Once Zeswitz knows that you want to return your instrument, they will give you a date, time and place to bring the instrument to drop off. There was one drop off last week at Penndale Middle School. Zeswitz is planning to have another drop off in the near future, but you MUST call to tell them and get on their list. Do not drop off your instrument on June 10. Schools will not be collecting Zeswitz instruments."
